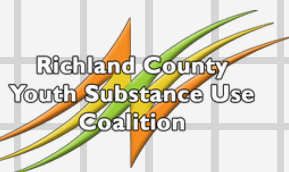

Winners of the prevention contest had their artwork on digital billboards for 3 months.



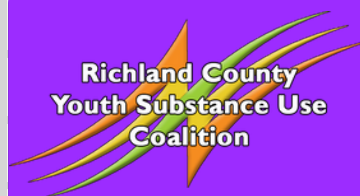
